## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-FIVE.

---

AN ACT for the better protection of fish in Barker, Middle  
and South East ponds in Hiram and Sebago, in the coun-  
ties of Oxford and Cumberland.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No person shall fish for or take fish of any  
2 kind from the ponds known as Barker, Middle and South  
3 East ponds, in Hiram and Sebago in the counties of Oxford  
4 and Cumberland for the term of two years from the date  
5 of this act.

SECT. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this  
2 act shall be punished by a fine of five dollars for each  
3 offense, and five dollars additional for each fish taken, to

4 be recovered by complaint before any trial justice or municipi-  
5 pal court, in said towns or county, one-half to the use of  
6 the prosecutor, and one-half to the towns where proceed-  
7 ings are commenced.
