STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in aid of completing a road in Jerusalem
Plantation in Franklin County.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred fifty dollars be,
2 and the same is hereby appropriated for the year 1895, to
3 be expended under the direction of the County Commis-
4 sioners of Franklin county, towards the completion of the
5 road from Drew's Mills in Jerusalem Plantation in Franklin
6 county, to the main road in Dead River Plantation in
7 Somerset county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This proposed road is about four and one-half miles long, connecting the valley of the Carrabasset river in Franklin county, with the Lower Dead River valley, near Dead River Plantation, is the shortest route, and has a very favorable location. Has had about \$1,500 expended on it already, is being used this winter quite extensively, and must be very encouraging to the settlers and business men, and help settle and develop that section. The cost of the road when completed, will be about \$2,500.

A little aid from the state now would insure an immediate completion of the grading, ditching and bridging of the road the coming spring, and be of great and permanent value to that section and the state.
