STATE OF MAINE.

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.**

AN ACT for the protection of fish in Sweet's Pond, Clear
Water Pond, and North or Varnum's Pond and their tribu-
taries, in Franklin county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All persons are prohibited from fishing
2 for, or taking fish of any kind from Sweet's pond situated
3 partially or wholly in the town of New Vineyard; Clear
4 Water pond, situated in the towns of Industry and Farm-
5 ington; and North or Varnum's pond, situated in the
6 towns of Temple and Wilton in Franklin county, between
7 the first day of October and the first day of May following
8 of each year for five years.

SECT. 2. All persons are prohibited from fishing for, or
2 taking fish of any kind from any of the tributaries of either
3 of said ponds, for the term of five years.

SECT. 3. Any person violating the provision of this
2 act shall be liable to a fine of ten dollars, and a further
3 fine of one dollar for each fish so taken, to be recovered on
4 complaint before any trial justice or municipal court in the
5 county of Franklin, or on indictment, one-half to the com-
6 plainant and one-half to aforesaid county.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
