IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the use of Purse and Drag Seines in the Georges River.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be lawful to use any purse or drag 2 seines in the waters of the Georges river, except for smelts.

SECT. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
