IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT authorizing the Building of a Wharf in Tide Waters in the Town of Harpswell.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. E. K. Hodgkins, Elisha A. Clark, Joseph 2 A. Stover, William V. Littlefield, their associates or 3 assigns, are hereby authorized to erect and maintain a 4 wharf in the town of Harpswell, at the southwest part of 5 Wood Landing Point, so called, near Lookout Point, on 6 Harpswell Neck, at Harpswell Center, extending in a 7 westerly direction sixty feet into tide waters of Casco bay, 8 in the county of Cumberland.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
