STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to relieve the inhabitants of the town of Cape Elizabeth from the inequalities of burdens imposed by chapter 216 of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. So much of the tax levied by the assessors 2 of the town of Cape Elizabeth in the year eighteen hun-3 dred and ninety-four, upon the tax payers of each of the 4 school districts in said town, for the purchase of the 5 school-houses, lands, apparatus and other property of the 6 several districts of said town, in accordance with the pro-

7 visions of chapter 216 of the Public Laws of the year 8 eighteen hundred and ninety-three, as is in excess of the 9 appraised valuation of all the property so purchased in 10 each of said districts, is hereby remitted, and no proceed-11 ings shall hereafter be had to collect such excess; and in 12 case said excess has been or shall be paid by any tax payer 13 in any of said school districts before this act becomes 14 operative, each of the present towns of Cape Elizabeth 15 and South Portland shall be liable to repay to such tax 16 payer such proportion of the excess so paid by him, as the 17 valuation of such town bears to the total valuation of both 18 towns, as shown by the assessors' books of the former 19 town of Cape Elizabeth for the year eighteen hundred and 20 ninety-four; and if such excess is not repaid within thirty 21 days after demand, the same may be recovered, in the 22 proportions aforesaid, from each of said towns, in an 23 action of the case brought by the tax payer who has paid 24 the same.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
