STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT in relation to School Lands and Funds in towns where the act incorporating them is repealed.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. When the incorporation of a town is re-2 pealed the care and custody of the school lands therein 3 reverts to the state land agent and he has the same powers 4 in relation thereto he would have if such town had never 5 been incorporated.

SECT. 2. When the incorporation of a town is repealed 2 the school funds thereof shall be collected and transmitted 3 to the state treasurer and by him made a part of the per-4 manent school fund belonging to such township or tract.

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5 The state land agent is charged with the duty of enforcing 6 the provisions of this section and is authorized to commence 7 and maintain suits in the name of the state for this pur-'8 pose.

SECT. 3. This act shall apply to past repeals of act of 2 incorporation.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
