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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend Section sixty-six of Chapter forty-nine  
of the Revised Statutes.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section sixty-six of chapter forty-nine of the Revised  
2 Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the follow-  
3 ing : 'Provided, that domestic mutual fire insurance com-  
4 panies shall be required to pay only the actual expenses  
5 incurred by the commissioner in making the examination  
6 herein required,' so that said section as amended shall  
7 read as follows :

'Section 66. Every such company shall organize within  
9 two years after its charter is granted, or its charter shall  
10 be void ; and upon such organization it shall inform the

11 commissioner thereof. No such company shall commence  
12 business by issuing policies, until the commissioner has  
13 examined and ascertained that it has complied with the  
14 terms of its charter, paid in its capital stock and become  
15 qualified to act; and he shall then issue to it his certificate  
16 of that fact, for which service he shall receive from it  
17 twenty dollars and all traveling expenses; and annually  
18 thereafter upon examination, so long as the same is found  
19 solvent and responsible to do business, he shall issue to it  
20 a like certificate and receive a like fee. Provided, that  
21 domestic mutual fire insurance companies shall be required  
22 to pay only the actual expenses incurred by the commis-  
23 sioner in making the examination required by law.'
