**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.**

AN ACT to authorize the town of Fort Fairfield to fund its
indebtedness at maturity and to issue new bonds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The town of Fort Fairfield is hereby au-
2 thorized to fund its indebtedness at maturity, and for this
3 purpose to issue bonds, in such form and amount, and with
4 such rates of interest, and payable at such times and in such
5 manner as shall be determined by vote of said town, under
6 a proper article in the warrant at a legal town meeting ;
7 provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall
8 authorize any increase in the indebtedness of said town.

SECT. 2. To carry into effect the provisions of this act,
2 said town is hereby authorized to pass such votes, as may

3 be deemed necessary and proper, to enter into and make
4 any contract or agreement not inconsistent with the laws of
5 this state.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
