STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to prohibit the taking of certain fish in streams
which flow into Anonymous pond in the town of Harrison,
Cumberland county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from
2 fishing for, catching, killing or destroying any fish, suckers
3 excepted, in any of the streams that flow directly or indi-
4 rectly into Anonymous pond in the town of Harrison in
5 the county of Cumberland, for a term of four years.

SECT. 2. All persons violating the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to a fine of ten dollars for the offense,
3 and one dollar additional for each and every fish taken,

4 killed or destroyed. The fines and penalties to be enforced
5 in accordance with the provisions of law applicable to the
6 general fish and game laws.
