STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT for the protection of manufacturers of Maple Sugar
and Maple Syrup.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No person or persons shall sell or offer for
2 sale as maple sugar or syrup any article made in adultera-
3 tion or imitation of maple sugar or syrup.

SECT. 2. Any person or persons violating the provi-
2 sions of the preceding section shall be punished by a fine
3 of not less than twenty-five dollars and not more than one
4 hundred dollars, or imprisonment in the county jail for
5 thirty days, or both, in the discretion of the court.

SECT. 3. One-half the fine to be paid complainant and
2 balance to the county in which said case is brought.
