IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section thirty-three of chapter 83, of the Revised Statutes, relating to Justices of the Peace and Quorum.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 33 of chapter 83 of the Revised Statutes, is 2 hereby amended by adding after the words "trial justices" 3 in the first line and after the words "trial justices" in the 4 third line, the words 'and judges of municipal and police 5 courts,' so that said section as amended shall read as fol-6 lows:

'Section 33. Trial justices and judges of municipal and 8 police courts are ex-officio, justices of the peace and of the 9 quorum, and all their official acts, attested by them in

10 either capacity, except those pertaining to the exclusive 11 jurisdiction of trial justices and judges of municipal and 12 police courts, are of equal effect.'
