STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Bath Military and Naval Orphan Asylum.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated for 2 the Bath Military and Naval Orphan Asylum, the sum of 3 eight thousand and five hundred dollars for the year eigh-4 teen hundred and ninety-five, and eight thousand five hun-5 dred dollars for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-six. 6 Also the sum of five hundred dollars for sewerage; and 7 also one thousand dollars for repairs for eighteen hundred 8 and ninety-five and eighteen hundred and ninety-six.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The appropriation made by the last legislature for this institution was \$8,000 each year. A legacy was left the institution of some \$2000, which, by some flaw in the will, has been decided against the institution. The trustees expected to make such repairs as were necessary, including sewerage with the bequest. This failing to materialize, leaves them with a shortage of nearly \$1,000 for the two years. The trustees ask for \$500 increase for each year, and believe that it will be, with prudent management, sufficient to meet the necessary expenses.
