## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to incorporate the Franklin County Fish and Game Association.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- 12 Industry, with their associates and successors, are hereby 13 incorporated into a body politic, by the name of the 14 Franklin County Fish and Game Association.
- SECT. 2. This corporation, for the purpose of protect2 ing game and fish by aiding in the enforcement of the laws
  3 of the state relating thereto, of cultivating and propagating
  4 game and fish, and of introducing new species and varieties,
  5 is hereby empowered, for such purposes, to take by pur6 chase, bequest, or otherwise, and to hold, transfer, and
  7 convey real and personal property to the amount of twenty
  8 thousand dollars.
- SECT. 3. Said corporation shall have power to prose2 cute and defend suits at law and in equity; to enter and
  3 prosecute complaints against any person or persons for
  4 violation of any of the laws of the state for the protec5 tion of game or fish, and to recover and receive all penal6 ties and forfeitures that would be recovable to any person
  7 making such complaints; to construct hatcheries for the
  8 cultivation and propagation of inland fish; to have and to
  9 use a common seal; and to be governed by a code of
  10 by-laws not inconsistent with the laws of the state.
- SECT. 4. The first meeting of said corporation may be 2 called by any three of the corporators, by a notice specify-3 ing the time and place of such meeting, published in any 4 paper of the town of Farmington, at least one week prior 5 to the time fixed for said meeting.
  - Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
