STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend and extend the charter of the Waldo and Somerset Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The Waldo and Somerset Railway Company, organized 2 under the provisions of their charter, granted by chapter 3 283 of the Private and Special Laws of the year 1887, is 4 hereby authorized to extend the location of their railroad, 5 and to construct, operate and maintain a railroad of standard 6 or narrow guage, from the junction of the Belfast and 7 Moosehead Lake Railroad with the Maine Central Railroad 8 at Burnham village, to Canaan village, thence northerly 9 through Cornville between the east and west ridges, to 10 the village of Athens, in accordance with the provisions 11 of their said charter and its amendments. And said cor-12 poration is hereby authorized to operate said railroad by13 steam and by electricity.
