STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled “An Act to establish a
Bounty on Seals.”

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and
2 thirty-nine of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and
3 ninety-one is hereby amended by striking out in the first
4 line the words “fifty cents” and substituting the words
5 ‘one dollar and fifty cents,’ and in the second line by
6 striking out the words “Penobscot river and bay” and
7 substituting the words ‘this state’ so that said section as
8 amended shall read as follows:

‘Section 1. A bounty of one dollar and fifty cents for
10 each and every seal killed in the waters of this state shal

11 be paid by the treasurer of the town in which such seal is
12 killed to the person exhibiting to said treasurer the nose
13 of such seal within thirty days after said seal was killed
14 such treasurer shall destroy it and shall then proceed as
15 in section six and seven of chapter thirty of the Revised
16 Statutes.'

SECT. 2. Section two of said chapter is hereby amended
2 by striking out said "section" and substituting in place
3 thereof the following :

'Section 2. The carcasses of such seals when destroyed
5 shall not be left derelict in any waters of the state, but
6 shall be removed therefrom and properly disposed of by
7 the person destroying them, under a penalty for a viola-
8 tion of the provisions of this section of fifty dollars, to be
9 recovered upon complaint or indictment before any court
10 of competent jurisdiction.

SECT. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
2 this act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
