
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to legalize and make valid the acts of the town of Fayette.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The acts and doings of the town of Fayette, 2 at its annual meetings held in March, in the years 1890, 3 1891, 1892, 1893 and 1894 in pursuance of the respective 4 warrants, calling said meetings, are hereby made legal and 5 valid, notwithstanding any defect, or omissien in any date 6 in said warrants.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
