AN ACT to allow the Velasco Company to purchase, hold and dispose of the stock of other corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The Velasco Company, organized under the general 2 laws of this state, is hereby authorized and empowered to 3 purchase, hold, use, and dispose of the stock and bonds of 4 other corporations organized under the laws of this or 5 other states for the purpose of engaging in business simi-6 lar to, auxiliary to, relating to, or necessary for the busi-7 ness described in the articles of association and certificate 8 of organization of said Velasco Company.
