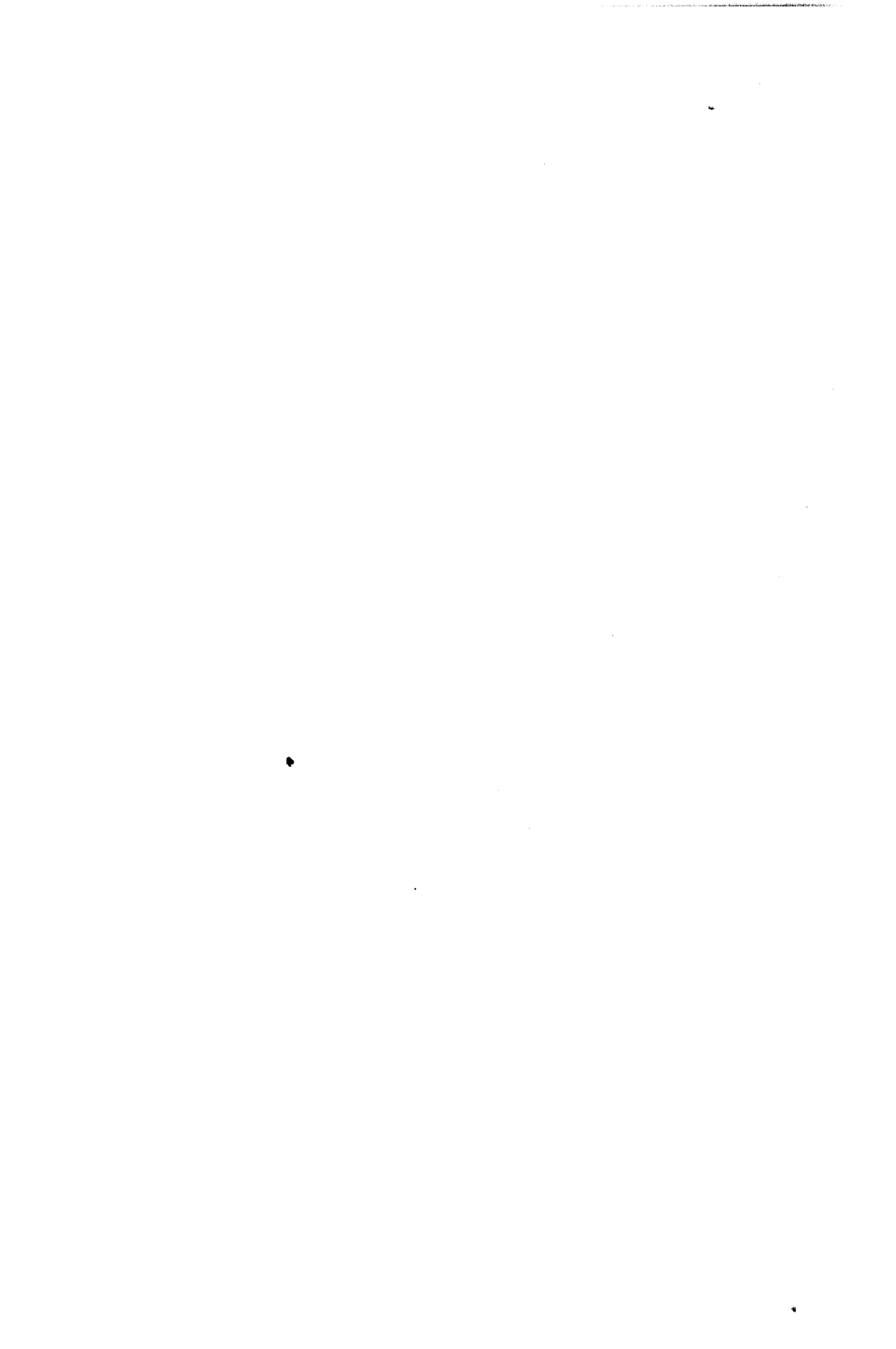

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to allow the Velasco Company to purchase, hold
and dispose of the stock of other corporations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

The Velasco Company, organized under the general
2 laws of this state, is hereby authorized and empowered to
3 purchase, hold, use, and dispose of the stock and bonds of
4 other corporations organized under the laws of this or
5 other states for the purpose of engaging in business simi-
6 lar to, auxiliary to, relating to, or necessary for the busi-
7 ness described in the articles of association and certificate
8 of organization of said Velasco Company.
