STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to prohibit fishing through the ice in Tilton pond,
Basin pond, Watson cove, Fayette Mill pond, and Lovejoy
pond, situated in Fayette and Wayne, in Kennebec county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from
2 fishing through the ice for a term of four years in Tilton
3 pond, Basin pond, Watson cove, Fayette Mill pond, and
4 Lovejoy pond, all situated in Fayette and Wayne in Ken-
5 nebec county.

SECT. 2. All persons violating the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to a fine of ten dollars, and one dollar
3 additional for each fish so taken. The fines and penalties

4 under this act, shall be enforced as provided for the viola-
5 tion of the fish and game laws.
