IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to prohibit fishing through the ice in Tilton pond,
Basin pond, Watson cove, Fayette Mill pond, and Lovejoy
pond, situated in Fayette and Wayne, in Kennebec county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. All persons are hereby prohibited from 2 fishing through the ice for a term of four years in Tilton 3 pond, Basin pond, Watson cove, Fayette Mill pond, and 4 Lovejoy pond, all situated in Fayette and Wayne in Ken-5 nebec county.

SECT. 2. All persons violating the provisions of this 2 act shall be subject to a fine of ten dollars, and one dollar 3 additional for each fish so taken. The fines and penalties
