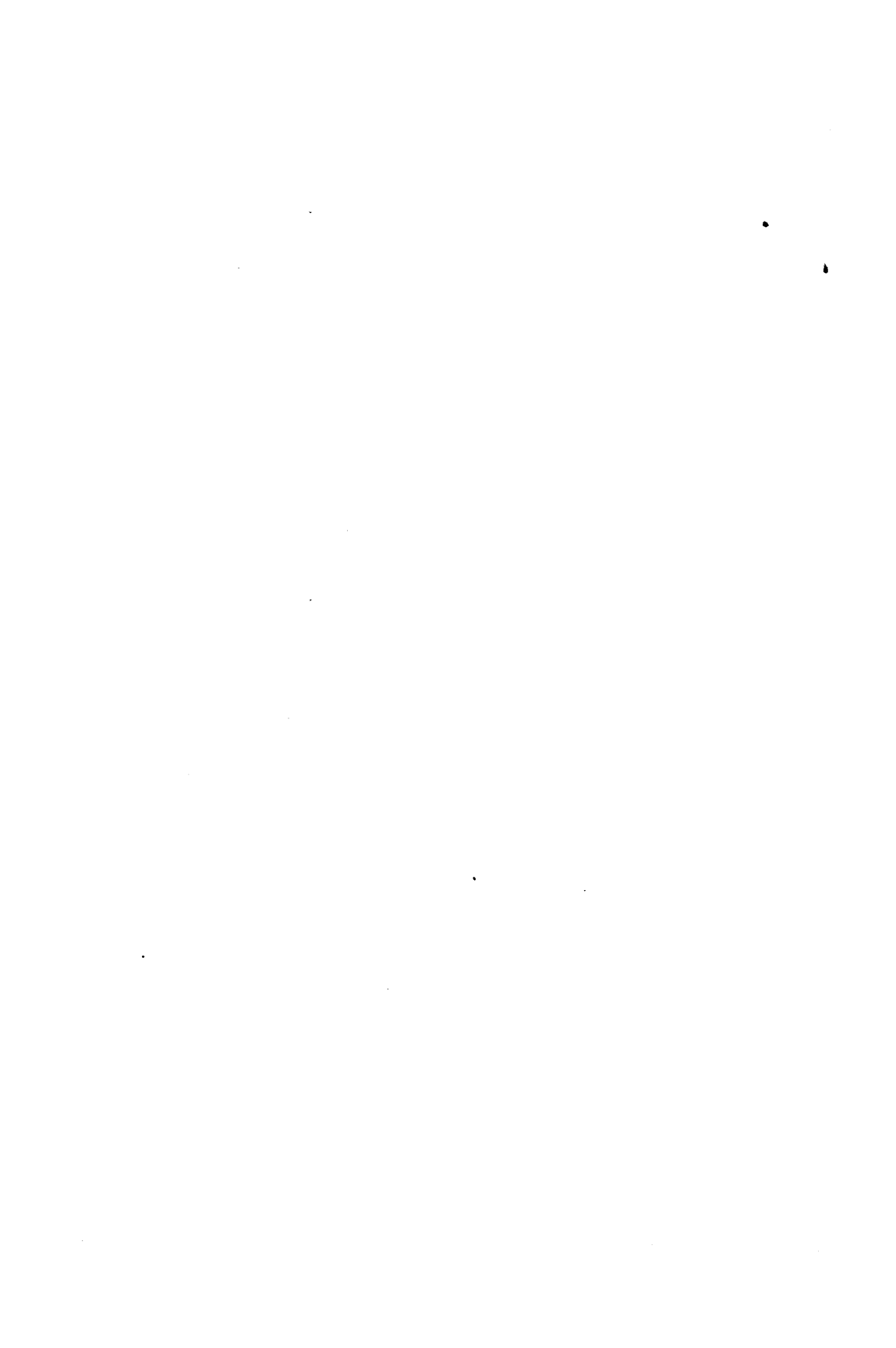
AN ACT to prohibit the taking of fish in Pierce's and  
White's pond and tributaries in the town of Penobscot,  
Hancock county.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. All persons are prohibited from fishing for,  
2 taking, catching, killing or destroying for a term of two  
3 years, any land-locked salmon or trout, from Pierce's and  
4 White's pond in the town of Penobscot, Hancock county,  
5 and from all streams emptying into the same, under a pen-  
6 alty of ten dollars for each offense, and one dollar addi-  
7 tional for each and every fish taken in violation of this act.

SECT. 2. All fines and penalties under this act shall be  
2 enforced as provided in cases of violation of the game laws.
