STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to prohibit the taking of fish in Pierce's and White's pond and tributaries in the town of Penobscot, Hancock county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. All persons are prohibited from fishing for, 2 taking, catching, killing or destroying for a term of two 3 years, any land-locked salmon or trout, from Pierce's and 4 White's pond in the town of Penobscot, Hancock county, 5 and from all streams emptying into the same, under a pen-6 alty of ten dollars for each offense, and one dollar additional for each and every fish taken in violation of this act.

SECT. 2. All fines and penalties under this act shall be 2 enforced as provided in cases of violation of the game laws.
