STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to prohibit the taking of Trout from Meadow
Brook and its tributaries in the town of Hanover in
Oxford County.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No person shall take, catch, fish for, kill
2 or destroy any trout in Meadow brook, or its tributaries,
3 emptying into Howard's pond in the town of Hanover,
4 county of Oxford for the term of six years from the ap-
5 proval of this act.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions
2 of this act, shall be liable to a fine of ten dollars, and a

3 further fine of one dollar for each fish so taken, to be recov-
4 ered on complaint before any trial justice in said county
5 one-half to the complainant and one-half to the said county
6 of Oxford.
