STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to prohibit the taking of Trout from Meadow Brook and its tributaries in the town of Hanover in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. No person shall take, catch, fish for, kill 2 or destroy any trout in Meadow brook, or its tributaries, 3 empting into Howard's pond in the town of Hanover, 4 county of Oxford for the term of six years from the ap-5 proval of this act.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions 2 of this act, shall be liable to a fine of ten dollars, and a

3 further fine of one dollar for each fish so taken, to be recov-4 ered on complaint before any trial justice in said county 5 one-half to the complainant and one-half to the said county 6 of Oxford.
