STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT relative to the use of Street Railway Tracks in the City of Bangor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Any other street railway, incorporated now or hereafter,

- 2 to run cars within the city of Bangor where the Public
- 3 Works Company controlling and operating the Bangor
- 4 Street Railway may have no track, may enter upon and
- 5 connect with and use the tracks of the Public Works
- 6 Company or Banger street railway on the terms provided
- 7 for in charter of Bangor street railway granted by the
- 8 legislature of Maine, and approved February 15, 1887.
- 9 And said Public Works Company or said Bangor Street
- 10 Railway may run its cars over the tracks, within the city

11 of Bangor, of any other street railway which may lay its
12 tracks in said city where said Public Works Company or
13 said Bangor Street Railway may have no track; compen14 sation and terms to be fixed as provided for in the case of
15 such other companies using the rails of Bangor Street
16 Railway, in section eighth of said charter of Bangor Street
17 Railway.
