IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 304 of the Public Laws of 1893,
relating to the Registration of Voters.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Chapter 304 of the Public Laws of 1893 is hereby
2 amended by adding thereto the following section :

‘Section 36. Nothing in this act shall be so construed
4 as to require any voter, whose name is already upon any
5 ward list and who afterwards moves from said ward to
6 any other ward in said city, to appear personally before
7 said board during the revision of the lists in order to
8 transfer his name from one ward list to another.’
