**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.**

AN ACT to legalize the acts and doings of the town of
Monroe.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECT. 1. The acts and doings of the town of Monroe
2 at its annual meeting of March fifth, eighteen hundred and
3 ninety-four, in pursuance of the warrant are hereby legal-
4 ized and made valid notwithstanding an error in the date
5 of the warrant calling said meeting.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
