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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-FIVE.

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AN ACT to incorporate the Carrabassett Water Power  
Company.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Mark Emery, Ben S. Collins, Wallace  
2 Emery and Gould A. Porter, their associates and assigns,  
3 are hereby incorporated under the name of the Carrabassett  
4 Water Power Company, with all the powers and privileges  
5 of similar corporations.

SECT. 2. Said corporation is hereby empowered and  
2 authorized to build a dam at the outlets of Middle Carry-  
3 ing Place pond and Rowe pond, both of said ponds being  
4 in Somerset county, and to flow said ponds and to deepen  
5 and widen the channels at the outlets of said ponds, there-

6 by enabling them to store water in Sandy stream and Car-  
7 rabassett river, in times of drought either in summer or  
8 winter, and they also use said water to facilitate the driving  
9 of logs and lumber down Sandy stream and Carrabassett river.

SECT. 3. Said company may take all necessary land  
2 and materials for building said dam and widening and  
3 deepening the outlets of said ponds and may flow contigu-  
4 ous lands so far as necessary to raise suitable heads of  
5 water ; and if the parties cannot agree on the damages the  
6 corporation shall pay the proprietors for land and material  
7 so taken, such damages as shall be ascertained and deter-  
8 mined by the county commissioners of Somerset county  
9 in the same manner and under the same conditions and  
10 limitations as provided by law in case of damage by lay-  
11 ing out of highways ; and for damages occasioned by flow-  
12 ing land, said company shall not be liable to an action at  
13 common law, but the proceedings shall be had as when  
14 a complaint is made under the statutes of this state for  
15 flowing lands occasioned by raising a head of water for  
16 the working of mills.

SECT. 4. Said company may issue its capital stock to  
2 an amount not exceeding five thousand dollars, to be divided  
3 into shares of one hundred dollars each.

SECT. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
