STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE relating to copying plans of Maine towns.

Resolved, That the land agent be and hereby is directed
2 to continue the work of copying the old plans of Maine
3 towns now in the archives of the state of Massachusetts,
4 and that the sum of one thousand dollars be appropriated
5 for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five, and the sum
6 of one thousand dollars for the year eighteen hundred and
7 ninety-six for that purpose.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

There are several hundred plans of Maine towns and tracts of land that are now in the State House in Massachusetts, that should be in land office in this State and also in the registries of deeds in the several counties of this State. This appropriation is to continue the work for two years more.
