STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to protect trout in the ponds and streams in the town of Troy, in the county of Waldo.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. No trout shall be caught, taken or destroyed 2 from any of the ponds, brooks or streams in the town of 3 Troy, county of Waldo, for a period of two years.

SECT. 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions 2 of this act shall be liable to a penalty of ten dollars for the 3 offense and one dollar additional for every trout taken, 4 caught or destroyed, to be recovered on complaint before

5 any trial justice in the county of Waldo, one-half of said 6 fines to go to the complainant and the other to the county 7 where the complaint is made.
