STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to prevent the use of narrow rimmed Wheels on Greenfield road in town of Greenbush.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. No person or persons shall haul any freight 2 or merchandise over the Greenfield road so called which 3 runs through the town of Greenbush, with a team if drawn 4 by three horses, oxen or mules, upon wheels of less than 5 five inches tread of breadth of rim.

SECT. 2. Any person violating the provisions of the fore-2 going section shall pay a fine of ten dollars for each offense, 3 with costs of prosecution, to be recovered on complaint of 4 any officer of said town of Greenbush, before any munici5 pal court or trial justice of the county of Penobscot, and 6 all fines collected under this act shall forthwith be paid 7 into the treasury of said town of Greenbush.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 2 and after the fifteenth day of May in the year of our Lord 3 one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five.
