STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE laying a tax on Counties of the State for the years eighteen hundred and ninety-five and eighteen hundred and ninety-six.

Resolved, That the sum annexed to the counties in the 2 following schedule is hereby granted as a tax on each 3 county respectively, to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied to the purposes of paying the debts 4 and necessary expenses of the same, and for other purposes 5 ordered by law, for the year one thousand eight 6 hundred and ninety-five. Androscoggin, thirty-five thousand 7 dollars; Aroostook, forty-five thousand five hundred 8 dollars; Cumberland, ninety thousand dollars; Franklin, 9 twelve thousand five hundred dollars; Hancock, twenty- 10 one thousand dollars; Kennebec, thirty-five thousand seven- 11 ty-four dollars; Knox, twenty-five thousand dollars; 12 Lincoln, nine thousand eight hundred seventy-five dollars; 13
