STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT for the protection of Fish in all the tributaries to Royals' river in the town of Gray.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. No person shall fish for or take fish of any 2 kind, from any of the tributaries to Royals' river in the 3 town of Gray, in the county of Cumberland, for a term of 4 two years from the date of this act.

SECT. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this 2 act shall be punished by a fine of ten dollars for each offence, 3 and one dollar additional for each fish taken, to be 4 recovered by complaint before any trial justice or munici-5 pal court in said county, one-half to the use of the prose-6 cutor, and one-half to the county.
