STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT for the protection of Fish in all the tributaries to
Royals' river in the town of Gray.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No person shall fish for or take fish of any
2 kind, from any of the tributaries to Royals' river in the
3 town of Gray, in the county of Cumberland, for a term of
4 two years from the date of this act.

SECT. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this
2 act shall be punished by a fine of ten dollars for each offence,
3 and one dollar additional for each fish taken, to be
4 recovered by complaint before any trial justice or municipi-
5 pal court in said county, one-half to the use of the prose-
6 cutor, and one-half to the county.
