STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT relating to the Boothbay Railroad Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The location of the Boothbay Railroad
2 Company from tide waters in Boothbay Harbor to a con-
3 nection with Knox & Lincoln division of Maine Central
4 Railroad, as filed with the board of county commissioners
5 of Lincoln county, and the proceedings in organization
6 of said company under its charter, are hereby ratified,
7 approved and confirmed as legal and valid.

SECT. 2. The time within which said company may
2 commence construction of its line is hereby extended two
3 years from and after the date fixed in the act of incorpora-
4 tion, and within that time said company may, if deemed
5 expedient or necessary, amend its location. And it may
6 take, hold and dispose of stock and bonds in other cor-
7 porations with which it may connect.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
