## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-FIVE.

---

AN ACT for the better protection of fish in Three Mile pond,  
in China, Windsor and Vassalboro, in the county of Ken-  
nebec.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. No person shall be permitted to fish for or  
2 take any pickerel by fishing through the ice, from Three  
3 Mile pond in the towns of China, Windsor and Vassalboro  
4 in the county of Kennebec, excepting on Saturdays of each  
5 week, and then only for the purpose of conveying the same  
6 to their homes for consumption. Provided further that  
7 when fishing through the ice, lines shall not be allowed to  
8 remain during the night.

SECT. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this  
2 act, shall be liable to a fine of ten dollars for the offense,  
3 and one dollar additional for every fish taken in violation  
4 to be recovered on complaint before any trial justice in  
5 Kennebec county, one half to the use of the complainant,  
6 and one half to the use of said county.
