### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the erection of a wharf into tide waters by Orville D. Lambard.

# Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Orville D. Lambard, his associates and 2 assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to erect 3 and maintain a wharf in the Kennebec river, at Augusta, 4 beginning at some point in said river, opposite the land of 5 the late Julia E. Johnson, where a vessel can draw not 6 exceeding ten feet of water at average high tides, for the 7 month of July, and extending easterly to the shore. The 8 river end of said wharf shall contain not less than five

9 piers, each not exceeding ten feet east and west, having a 10 space of forty feet between the two westerly piers, and 11 thirty feet between each of the others. Provided the 12 Augusta Lumber Company, their successors or assigns 13 shall have the right to hitch booms, lines or chains to 14 piers of said wharf for the purpose of facilitating the driv-15 ing of logs.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
