**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.**

AN ACT to amend section 84 of chapter 6 of the Revised
Statutes, relating to Ways in Unincorporated Places.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section eighty-four of chapter six of the Revised Statutes
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "county"
3 in the third line the words 'or when such roads become
4 blocked with snow,' and by inserting after the word
5 "repaired" in the same line, the words 'and made possible,'
6 so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 84. County commissioners, in case of sudden
8 injury to county roads and bridges in unincorporated town-
9 ships and tracts of land in their counties, or when such
10 roads become blocked with snow, may cause them to be

11 repaired and made passable forthwith, or as soon as they
12 deem necessary, and may appoint an agent or agents not
13 members of their own board, to superintend the expendi-
14 ture therefor, who shall give bonds as required in section
15 seventy-eight, if required, the whole expense thereof shall
16 be added to their next assessment on said lands for repairs,
17 authorized by section eighty, which assessment shall create
18 a lien upon said lands for the whole amount thereof as
19 effectually as is now provided in relation to repairs on such
20 county roads. That portion of said assessment which is
21 for repairs of sudden injuries as aforesaid, shall be set
22 down, in the assessment, in direct items, in a separate
23 column, and shall not be discharged, under section eighty-
24 one, but shall be enforced as is provided in section eighty-
25 two.
