STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 8, of chapter 115, of the Revised
Statutes, relating to compensation of Members of the
Legislature.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The second paragraph of section eight of
2 the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out
3 the words "one hundred and fifty" in the second line
4 thereof and substituting in lieu therefor the words 'three
5 hundred,' so that said paragraph shall read as follows:

'SECT. 2. Each member of the senate and house of
7 representatives shall receive three hundred dollars for the
8 regular session of the legislature and two dollars for every

9 ten miles travel from his place of abode once in each
10 session.'

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect January first, eighteen
2 hundred and ninety-seven.
