## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing for State Pensions for invalid Soldiers and Sailors who served on the quota of Maine in the war of eighteen hundred and sixty-one, their widows and orphans and the dependent children, parents and sisters of soldiers and sailors.

Resolved, That the sum of seventy thousand dollars be 2 and is hereby appropriated to provide for state pensions 3 for invalid soldiers and sailors who served in the war of 4 eighteen hundred and sixty-one, on the quota of Maine, 5 their widows and orphans, and the dependent children, 6 parents and sisters of soldiers and sailors for the year 7 eighteen hundred and ninety-five, and seventy thousand 8 dollars for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-six.
