
AN ACT to repeal the Act Incorporating the Town of Kossuth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The act entitled an act to incorporate the 2 town of Kossuth, approved February 23, 1876, is hereby 3 repealed; provided, however, that the corporate existence, 4 powers, duties and liabilities of said town shall survive 5 for the purpose of prosecuting and defending all pending 6 suits and causes of suits to which said town is or may be 7 a party, and for the execution of all needful processes 8 growing out of the same, and for the further purpose of

9 providing for the payment of all or any judgments which 10 may be recovered against said town.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 2 and after its approval by the governor.
