## STATE OF MAINE.

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 249 of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred ninety-three, in relation to boundary lines on the Damariscotta river.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 5 of chapter 249 of the Public Laws of 1893 is 2 hereby amended by striking out the word "Merrill's" in 3 the fourth line, and inserting the word 'The' in place 4 thereof, so that when amended, it shall read as follows:

'Section 5. In the Damariscotta river, above a line 6 drawn from Farnham's head, in the town of Boothbay, to a 7 point opposite, on the shore in the town of Bristol, 8 excepting the use of drag seines between the above line 9 and "The Ledges," for all fish excepting alewives."
