STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That the trustees of the Maine insane hospital
2 are hereby authorized and instructed to erect at some
3 place on the hospital premises, at Augusta, a suitable
4 building or buildings according to plans and specifications,
5 to be provided by said trustees and approved by the gov-
6 ernor and council. Said buildings to be so located,
7 designed and constructed as to render them specially
8 adapted for the treatment and care of the chronic and
9 incurable insane, and of sufficient capacity to properly
10 provide for the accommodation of this class of patients, not
11 exceeding three hundred persons. The cost of said build-
12 ings complete with furniture not to exceed one hundred
13 thousand dollars; this being in conformity with the rec-

14 ommendations submitted in Senate Document Number
15 One, by the commission created by resolve of the legisla-
16 ture of 1893, consisting of the governor and council and
17 trustees of the Maine insane hospital. The sum of one
18 hundred thousand dollars is hereby appropriated for the
19 purpose above named, payable during the year 1895, pro-
20 vided that before contracts for the foregoing buildings and
21 furnishings are made, proposals shall be advertised for,
22 and contracts shall be awarded to the lowest bidder, with
23 the right to reject any or all bids.
