STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to legalize the vote of the town of Kittery to raise money for the Purchase of the Kittery Point Bridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Whereas the town of Kittery at its annual meeting in March, eighteen hundred and ninety-four voted: That the town appropriate the sum of seventeen hundred (\$1,700) dollars to purchase the Kittery Point bridge and make the same a free bridge. Seven hundred (\$700) dollars to be raised this year, and the town treasurer be authorized to negotiate a loan for the balance at three and one-half per cent ($3\frac{1}{2}$ per cent) per annum. Therefore be it enacted:

SECTION 1. Said vote is hereby ratified and said town 2 is hereby authorized to raise said money in accordance with

3 said vote at any time after the value of said bridge is finally 4 determined by the proceedings now in progress therefor.

SECT. 2. The county commissioners of the county of 2 York are hereby authorized to determine the proportional 3 part of said value to be paid respectively by said town and 4 said county. And when said part is so determined said 5 town and said county shall each be liable for the amount 6 thereof. ,
