IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-FIVE.

---

AN ACT to legalize the vote of the town of Kittery to raise  
money for the Purchase of the Kittery Point Bridge.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Whereas the town of Kittery at its annual meeting in March, eighteen hundred and ninety-four voted: That the town appropriate the sum of seventeen hundred (\$1,700) dollars to purchase the Kittery Point bridge and make the same a free bridge. Seven hundred (\$700) dollars to be raised this year, and the town treasurer be authorized to negotiate a loan for the balance at three and one-half per cent ( $3\frac{1}{2}$  per cent) per annum. Therefore be it enacted:

SECTION 1. Said vote is hereby ratified and said town  
2 is hereby authorized to raise said money in accordance with

3 said vote at any time after the value of said bridge is finally  
4 determined by the proceedings now in progress therefor.

SECT. 2. The county commissioners of the county of  
2 York are hereby authorized to determine the proportional  
3 part of said value to be paid respectively by said town and  
4 said county. And when said part is so determined said  
5 town and said county shall each be liable for the amount  
6 thereof.
