STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the county commissioners
of Aroostook county to build a Court House at Caribou in
said county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Aroostook
2 county are hereby authorized and directed to proceed
3 forthwith to construct of brick and furnish a suitable
4 court house at Caribou in said county, in which to hold
5 such terms of the supreme judicial, probate and insolvent
6 courts as may by law be held in said Caribou. Said
7 court house, completed and furnished shall cost the sum
8 of twenty thousand dollars. Provided, however, that
9 there shall be first tendered to said commissioners a good

10 and sufficient deed of a lot of land in the village of Cari-
11 bou, running to said county, free of charge to said county,
12 upon which to build said court house.

SECT. 2. Said commissioners are hereby authorized and
2 directed to obtain a loan or loans of money for said pur-
3 pose, and for said amount and cause notes or obligations of
4 said county, with coupons for interest not exceeding six
5 per cent to be issued upon such time as they may deem
6 expedient.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
