

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Town of Limerick.

Resolved, That the state treasurer is hereby authorized 2 and directed to pay to the town of Limerick, one hundred 3 ninety-two and 78-100 dollars (\$192.78), the same being to 4 refund to said town the amount paid in state tax for the 5 years 1893 and 1894, on account of a clerical error in the 6 valuation of said town as returned to the state assessors.
