
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to fix the salary and allowances of the Register of Deeds for the county of Kennebec.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The register of deeds for Kennebec county 2 shall receive an annual salary of fifteen hundred dollars 3 and an additional allowance of eight hundred dollars per 4 year for clerk hire, said salary to be paid from the county 5 treasury and to be instead of the fees now provided by law; 6 which fees shall be paid into the county treasury for the 7 use of said county.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect April first, in the 2 year of our Lord eighteen hundred and ninety-five.
