STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-FIVE.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled, "An Act to permit the towns of Boothbay Harbor and Southport to erect a Toll Bridge across Townsend Gut." Approved February 28, 1889.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The first section of said act is hereby 2 amended by striking out the word or words "twenty-five"


 ${f 3}$ in the twelfth line thereof and inserting instead the word

4 'twenty,' so that the said bridge shall be twenty feet wide

5 instead of twenty-five feet wide as provided in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
